

his checklist contains the names and indicates the occurrence of 370 species of birds (the most for any area of similar size in Colorado) that have been sighted at and near Barr Lake over the years.

Birders have been flocking to Barr Lake since the reservoir was created in the 1880's. Field records of bird sightings date back to this time. wSeveral prominent ornithologists, including Robert Niedrach, Alfred Bailey and Robert Rockwell, explored the area seeking to document the rich variety of birdlife. Located in what was shortgrass prairie, the lake is an oasis for wildlife offering a unique combination of grassland, forest, lake and marsh. Please help protect this valuable habitat!
